## 2011 PVMAC Membership

But do not attempt to fly without these memberships, it is for the safety and preservations of our clubs air fields.

## Plans for PVMAC in 2011

What will the PVMAC be doing in 2011. Well we have lot's to discuss and lot's of decisions to make. We need to determine our clubs flying events for the year. We need to maintain both Norton and Prado air fields and obviously spend money to maintain them both.

## Field Plans for This Year

We also want to pour concrete in the picnic area to help keep dust down when we have events and the snack bar area is open. We have also looked into purchasing a water trailer to transport water into our facility. Several things to look forward to and we need your help to make these viable decisions for your club.

Prepare for a fun evening & a first hand look at new products from Horizon Hobby.


